



# Legionella Awareness Course

## Course Content

To provide delegates with information on Legionella Bacteria and Legionnaires Disease within the built environment. It will also provide necessary information on safe water system management and maintenance to ensure control measures and monitoring practices are correctly implemented thus achieving compliance with the requirements of the Approved Code of Practice L8.

On completion of the course, candidates should be able to gain an understanding of:

- ❖ What is Legionnaires disease?
- ❖ The history of the disease and legal precedent
- ❖ Who could be affected and its effects on the body
- ❖ How to comply with the HSE Approved Code of Practise L8
- ❖ How to assist with the management of Legionella bacteria within the workplace
- ❖ How to assist with the creation of a Legionella Management System
- ❖ How to assist with the implementation of the Legionella Management System
